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### **ORDER:**

In the letter read above, the Director of Town and Country Planning, has stated that Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has developed resettlement schemes in Chennai, Kancheepuram, Tiruvallur Districts as integrated township with basic and social infrastructures. The resettlement schemes namely Perumbakkam, Navalur, AIR Land and Gudapakam Schemes have been provided with social infrastructures like Ration shop, Community health centre, Milk Booth, Primary Health centre, library, ICDS Centre etc.

2. Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has constructed 20376 tenements at Perumbakkam in an extent of 200.57 Acres of land. The Slum families living along the banks of water bodies have been resettled in this scheme. As part of the programme, to beautify the resettlement schemes, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has proposed to take up measures at Perumbakkam to beautify and make green the area by planting of avenue trees, promote eco-tourism and develop the parks etc., The Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department has entrusted the work of raising nurseries at Permbakkam to SHGs and the formation of nurseries are in progress. In the approved layout of Permbakkam scheme, 28 No.of parks have been earmarked, of which 15 No.of Parks have been developed by Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board. The remaining 13 No.of Parks need to be developed and provided with Infrastructure to facilitate the development of green belt area within the scheme.

3. Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has therefore proposed to develop the 13 No. of parks at Perumbakkam by providing basic arrangements and plantation of trees. The cost for developing 13 No. of parks at Perumbakkam has been arrived at as Rs.430.00 lakh and the same is proposed to be met under the Infrastructure and Amenities fund.

4. The State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee have approved the proposal to sanction the said amount as Grant to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board. The Director of Town and Country Planning has also requested to sanction a sum of Rs.430.00 lakhs to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board towards development of 13 parks at Permbakkam under Infrastructure and Amenities Funds.

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Director of Town and Country Planning, and accord sanction for a sum of Rs.430.00 lakhs (Rupees Four crore and thirty lakhs only) to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board towards development of 13 parks at Permbakkam under Infrastructure and Amenities Funds for the year 2020-2021.

6. The amount sanctioned in para-5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

The amount sanctioned in para 5 above, shall be drawn by the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board on the basis of progress of work and utilisation certificate submitted by Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board and should be contra credited into personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board under the following head of account by means of cheque in favour of Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board:-

The Director of Town and Country Planning is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 4 above in "Account payee cheque in favour of personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board by indicating the Account number thereon and disburse the same to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board.

The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is requested to furnish a copy of this G.O. along with the details of expenditure incurred under para 4 above to the Director and Town and Country Planning for making necessary adjustments regarding the contra debit entries mentioned in para 5 through the Accountant General (A&E), Chennai at the close of Financial Year 2020-2021.

10. The expenditure sanctioned in para-5 above shall constitute an item of "**New Instrument of Service**" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawl of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director of Town and Country Planning is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the contingency Fund to Finance (BG.I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a



copy of this order. Order for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG.I) Department. The Director of Town and Country Planning is also directed to send necessary draft explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2020-2021 to Government in Finance (BG-I/Hg&UD) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
