Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board – Providing sewerage Infrastructure for Narimedu scheme in Pudukottai District at a cost of Rs.790.11 lakh – Sanction of funds under Infrastructure & Amenities Fund – Orders - Issued.

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ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued according Administrative Sanction for construction of 7204 tenements under 11 Affordable Housing Schemes in Partnership at a cost of Rs.571.76 crore with Government of Tamil Nadu grant of Rs.391.90 crore inclusive of institutional finance of Rs.185.56 crore and 16272 houses in 10 Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC) projects at a cost of Rs.441.16 crore with Government of Tamil Nadu grant of Rs.97.63 crore, of which, the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has to finance Rs.60.00 crore through loan from Housing and Urban Development Corporation Limited for construction of 10000 houses in 157 Town Panchayats.

2. In the letter third read above, the Director of Town and Country Planning has stated that a proposal seeking fund amounting to Rs.790.11 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities fund has been received from the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board for providing sewerage Infrastructure for the Narimedu Scheme in Pudukottai District. Further it has been stated that Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is constructing 1920 tenements at Narimedu in Pudukkottai under Affordable Housing Programme of Housing for All at a project cost of Rs.150.58 crore and this scheme is nearing completion. The sewerage infrastructure for this scheme needs to be provided before allotment of tenements.

3. The Director of Town and Country Planning has further stated that the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has requested Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board to provide sewerage infrastructure for the scheme. Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board has conducted the studies and concluded that the existing sewer network pipeline of Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board near the Narimedu scheme cannot be adequate to convey the sewage of the scheme. Therefore it suggested to convey the sewage to the existing 10.62 MLD capacity Sewage Treatment Plant of Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board at a distance of 6 km for which the diameter of the existing pipeline need to be increased to 400 mm. The total cost for the above work is arrived at Rs.790.11 lakh as per Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board's estimates.

4. As there are no provisions in the sanctioned Financial Statement of this scheme for the above work, the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has requested to sanction the sum of Rs.790.11 lakh towards the cost of providing sewerage network arrangements for the Narimedu Tenement scheme under Infrastructure and Amenities Funds.

5. The Director of Town and Country Planning has also stated that the amount of Rs.790.11 lakh sought by the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has been approved by the State Infrastructure and Promotion Committee.

6. The Director of Town and Country Planning has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders to sanction a sum of Rs.790.11 lakhs to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board to enable it to make payment to Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board for providing sewerage Infrastructure to Narimadu Scheme in Pudukottai District.

7. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Director of Town and Country Planning and accord approval to sanction a sum of Rs.790.11 lakh (Rupees Seven crore Ninety lakh and Eleven thousand only) to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board from the State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund to enable it to make payment to Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board for providing sewerage Infrastructure to Narimedu Scheme in Pudukottai District.

8. The amount sanctioned in the paragraph 7 above, shall be debited under the following heads of accounts:-

"2217 Urban Development – 05 Other Urban Development Schemes – 800 Other Expenditure – State's Expenditure – JW Assistance from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for Schemes implemented through TNSCB – 309 Grants-in-Aid – 02 Grants for Creation of Capital Assests".

The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be met from the State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund by adjusting under the Head of Account:

9. The amount sanctioned in para 7 above, shall be drawn by the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board on the basis of progress of work and utilization certificate submitted by Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board and should be contra credited into personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board under the following head of account by means of cheque in favour of Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board:-

The Director of Town and Country Planning is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 7 above in "Account payee cheque in favour of personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board by indicating the Account number thereon and disburse the same to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board.

11. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is requested to furnish a copy of this Government Order along with the details of expenditure incurred under para 7 above to the Director of Town and Country Planning for making necessary adjustments regarding the contra debit entries mentioned in para 8 through the Accountant General (A&E), Chennai at the close of Financial Year 2020-2021.

12. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which the Government in Finance (BG-I) Department will issue. The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning is directed to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG-I) Department, in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance required for the current year from Contingency Fund, without fail.

13. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.27053/Hg&UD/2020, dated 29.08.2020 and ASL No.419 (Four hundred and nineteen).
