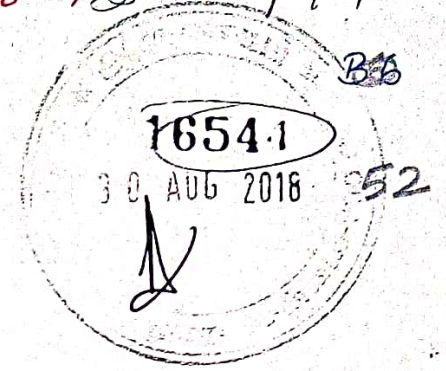

2. From the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning, Chennai Letter Roc. No. 13555/ 2016/NPD, dated. 29.08.2017.

ORDER:-

In the letter second read above, the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has stated that a proposal seeking funds amounting to Rs.210.00 lakh under Infrastructure and Amenities fund received from the Commissioner of Municipal Administration for the following projects.

SI. No.	Name of the Work	Estimate Cost (Rs in lakh)
1.	Construction of Storm Water Drain and Retaining Wall at Trichy Road (Four Road Signal) to Pollachi Bye-Pass Road (Opposite of Municipal Office) in ward No.9	210.00

2. Further, the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has stated as follows:-

- The Storm Water Drainage is flows opposite to the Palladam Municipal Office and between Trichy Road (four road signal) and Pollachi Bye-Pass Road upto 500 meters. It is located in centre of the town. The pedestrians and public are affected while crossing the Strom Water Drainage.
- The Commissioner of Municipal Administration has recommended the Proposal for sanction of funds under Infrastructure and Amenities.
- The above subject was placed before the 15th Infrastructure and Amenities Committee meeting held on 17.08.2017 vide Agenda No.7 and the committee decided as follows:

“The Committee discussed in detail and decided to sanction Rs.210.00 Lakh from Infrastructure and Amenities funds for the project.”

3. The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has therefore requested to sanction of Rs.210.00 lakh from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for construction of Storm Water Drain and Retaining Wall at Trichy Road (Four Road Signal) to Pollachi Bye-Pass Road (Opposite of Municipal Office) in Ward No.9.

4. The Government, after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning and accord sanction of Rs.2,09,75,000/- (Rupees Two crore nine lakh and seventy five thousand only) under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for construction of Storm Water Drain and Retaining Wall at Trichy Road to Pollachi Bye-pass Road in Ward No.9 with the following Estimated Cost:-

5. The amount sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited into the following head of account:-

“2217 - Urban Development – 05. Other Urban Development Schemes – 800. Other Expenditure – State’s Expenditure - KA. Schemes implemented in Urban Local Bodies under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund – 09. Grants in Aid – 02. Grants for Creation of Capital Assets”.
(DPC: 2217-05-800-KA-09 24), and

The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be adjusted under the following head of account By adjusting:-

"2217- Urban Development - 05 - Other Urban Development Schemes - State's Expenditure - 902 - Deduct - Amount met from Infrastructure Development Fund - JC. Amount met from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund - 30. Inter Account Transfers.
(DPC: 2217-05-902-JC-3002)

By contra debiting - "J. Reserve funds (b) Reserve Funds not bearing interest - 8229-00. Development and Welfare Funds - 200. Other Development and Welfare Funds - AZ - State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund. (DPC: 8229-00-200-AZ-0005) - (Outgo).

6. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RE / FMA 2018-19. Pending provision of funds, the Commissioner of Municipal Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para - 4 above. This expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by way of specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate 2018-19. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is requested to include the amount sanctioned in para 4 above, while sending budget proposal of RE / FMA 2018-19 and also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for Supplementary Estimates 2018-19 to Finance (MAWS / BG I/II) Department without fail.

7. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration shall furnish a copy of this Government Order along with the details of expenditure incurred from the funds sanctioned in para - 4 above to the Director of Town and Country Planning and the Accountant General (A&E), Chennai for making necessary adjustment entries mentioned in para 6 at the end of Financial Year 2018-19.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide it's U.O.No.41825/ MAWS/2018, dated 16.8.2018 with ASL No.1038 (One thousand and thirty eight).


