ORDER :-

The Principal Secretary/Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board in his letter 1st read above had sent a proposal to the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning seeking fund amounting to Rs.26.00 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for providing development works to 300 slums covering 75,282 families i.e., providing basic amenities like road, storm water drain, culverts, cement concrete pathway, street light etc., to improve the living conditions of the urban slums and make it habitable under Environmental Improvement of Urban Slums (EIUS) which would be handed over to the urban local bodies concerned for future maintenance.

2. The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning in the letter 2nd read above has stated that the Government provided grants through Budgetary support every year till 2014-15. Although, Rs.15 crore was allotted for the year 2015-16 under Infrastructure and Amenities funds of Directorate of Town and Country Planning for development of Urban Slums to be executed by Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, the funds could not be obtained from the Directorate of Town and Country Planning and hence the works were not executed during 2015 - 2016. This programme need to be continued especially in Municipal towns and Town Panchayats as these local bodies lack funds to implement such improvement works in slum areas.

3. The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has further stated that the proposals for providing development works in 300 slums covering 75,282 families at a cost of Rs.2,599.63 lakh in Coimbatore, Tiruppur, Erode, Namakkal, Salem, Karur, Ariyalur, Cuddalore, Thiruvarur, Nagapattinam, Thanjavur, Theni, Madurai, Sivagangai, Dindigul, Ramanathapuram, Virudhunagar, Tirunelveli, Kanyakumari and Thoothukudi Districts were approved by the Board for the year 2016-17 and submitted to Government for financial sanction under Environmental Improvement of Urban Slums (EIUS) and the Government has not sanctioned the proposal and provided funds in 2016-2017 under Environmental Improvement of Urban Slums (EIUS).

4. The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has further stated that the slum families in the above said districts are living in sub-optimal conditions and require immediate implementation of basic amenities to make their areas habitable and to improve their living conditions. The Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is proposed to implement the above proposal under Infrastructure and Amenities Funds of Directorate of Town and Country Planning. The Proposal was placed before the 15th Infrastructure and Amenities Committee meeting held on 17.08.2017 vide Agenda No.20 and the Committee decided as follows:

"The Committee discussed in detail and decided to recommend the Government to sanction Rs.26.00 crores for this proposal of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board subject to the condition that the work and estimates proposed under the environmental improvement of urban slums should be scrutinized and vetted by Finance Department".

5. The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has therefore, requested the Government to sanction Rs.26.00 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund to provide basic amenities to the 300 urban slums in the said districts as requested by the Principal Secretary/Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board.

6. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Commissioner of Town and Country Planning and accord sanction for a sum of Rs.24,26,85,000/- (Rupees Twenty four crore twenty six lakh and eighty five thousand only) for providing development works at 300 slums covering 75,282 slums in various districts of Tamil Nadu as mentioned in para -3 above under Environment Improvement of Urban Slums, including the provision of contingencies at 1%, Labour Welfare Fund at 1% and Supervision Charges at 5% by utilizing Infrastructure and Amenities Funds for the year 2018-19.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph -6 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-

"2217 Urban Development-05 Other Urban Development Schemes - 800 Other Expenditure - State's Expenditure JW- Assistance from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for Schemes implemented through TNSCB-09 Grants in Aid - 02 Grants for creation of Capital Assets.(DPC 2217-05-800-JW-0921)."

and contra debiting J.Reserve Funds.

(b) Reserve Funds not bearing interest 8229-00- Development and Welfare Fund - 200 Other Development and Welfare Fund- AZ - State Infrastructure and Amenities Funds.

(DPC 8229-00-200-AZ-0005). "(Outgo)"

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8. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 6 above shall be met from the State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund by adjusting under the Head of Account:-

"2217 Urban Development - 05 Other Urban Development Schemes-902 Deduct - Amount met from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund- State's- Expenditure JB - Amount met from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund 30 Inter Account Transfers". (DPC 2217-05-902-JB-3004).

9. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 6 above shall not be paid in cash but Credited to the following head of account:-

"K Deposits and Advances (b) Deposits not bearing interest - 8843. Civil Deposits - 800. Other Deposits - CA. Deposit of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board (TNSCB). (DPC 8443-00-800-CA-000J) (Receipts)".

10. Necessary additional funds of Rs.38,10,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2018-19 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para-6 above, pending provision of such funds The Commissioner of Town Country Planning is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para-6 above by means of an account payee cheque in favour of Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board by indicating the Account Number thereon and disburse the same to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board. This expenditure should be brought to the notice of Legislature by way of Specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2018-2019. The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning is requested to include the amount sanctioned in para-6 above, while sending the Budget Proposal of RE/FMA 2018-2019, and also to send necessary draft Explanatory Notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2018-2019 to Finance (B&I & Hg&UD) Department without fail.

11. The Principal Secretary/Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is requested to furnish a copy of the Government order along with the details of expenditure incurred under para-6 above to the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning for making necessary adjustments regarding contra debit entries mentioned in para-7 through Accountant General (A&E), Chennai at the end of the Financial year 2018-2019 and also to take necessary action to implement the above scheme after following the procedures in force and send a report to the Government along with an expenditure statement in due course.
