ORDER:

The Government, vide the order first read above, has accorded Administrative Sanction for revised project cost at Rs.391.72 crore for construction of 7048 tenements at 11 alternate locations in Coimbatore and to bear the additional State share of Rs.237.62 crore with the following funding pattern:-

The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board vide the reference second read above, has stated that the works on the construction of tenements in the above Urban Local Bodies are in advanced stage and the infrastructure works such as Water Supply, Sanitation arrangements, Storm Water Drain, Sewage Treatment plant, Roads, Pavements, Culverts, Street lights, Parks, and Community facilities are programmed for completion by June, 2016. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has therefore requested the Government to release the Additional State share of Rs.237.62 crore for the said works.

3. The Director of Town and Country Planning vide the reference third read above, has informed that the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee through Circulation Note has sanctioned Rs.237.62 crore and Rs.42.73 crore totaling a sum of Rs.280.35 crore for tenements construction projects at 11 different locations in Coimbatore and Ukkadam Phase-III as grant from the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund towards additional State share and has requested the Government to sanction Rs.237.62 crore as approved by the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee.

4. Further, the Commissioner of Municipal Administration vide the reference fourth read above, has requested the Government to release the Additional State Share of Rs.237.62 crore for tenements construction projects at the following 11 alternate Urban Local Bodies in Coimbatore under Basic Services to the Urban Poor component of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission.

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Director of Town and Country Planning / the Commissioner of Municipal Administration and accord sanction for Rs.237,62,28,000/- (Rupees Two hundred and thirty seven crore, sixty two lakh and twenty eight thousand only) as grant from the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund as approved by the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee towards additional State

share for construction of 7048 tenements projects at 11 alternate locations in Coimbatore as detailed at para 4 above under Basic Services to the Urban Poor component of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission.

6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Heads of Account:-

7. Necessary funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2016-17. Pending provision of funds in RE/FMA 2016-17 the Commissioner of Municipal Administration is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 5 above by means of an account payee cheque drawn in favour of "Commissioner of Municipal Administration's BSUP / IHSDP Savings Account No.50100062940381" maintained in the HDFC Bank, Chennai.

8. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration shall furnish a copy of this Government Order along with the details of expenditure incurred out of the funds sanctioned in para 5 above to the Director of Town and Country Planning and the Accountant General (A&E), Chennai for making necessary adjustment entries mentioned in para 6 at the close of Financial Year 2016-2017.
