Greater Chennai Corporation - Construction of High level bridges across Cooum River at Chinna Nolambur connecting Poonamallee High Road - Release of second instalment for an amount of Rs.14.09 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund - Sanctioned - Orders - Issued.

Order:

During the demand of Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department for the year 2022-23, the Hon'ble Minister for Municipal Administration has made the following announcement:

"பெருநகர சென்னை மாநகராட்சியின் கூவம் ஆற்றின் குறுக்கே யூனியன் சாலையையும், பூந்தமல்லி நெடுஞ்சாலையையும் இணைக்கும் வகையில் சின்ன நொளம்பூர் மற்றும் ஓம்சக்தி நகர் ஆகிய இடங்களில் 2 உயர் மட்ட பாலங்கள் ரூ.120 கோடி மதிப்பீட்டில் அமைக்கப்படும்".

- 2. Accordingly, in the Government Order second read above, among others, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for the construction of high level bridges across cooum river at Chinna Nolambur connecting Poonamallee High Road and Union Road at an estimated cost of Rs.42.71 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund.
- 3. In the Government Order third read above, among others, the Government have accorded sanction and released the 1st instalment of

33% of the project cost for the construction of High level bridges across Cooum River connecting Ponnamallee High Road and Union Road at Chinna Nolambur for an amount of Rs.14.09 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund

4. In the letter fourth read above, the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner, Greater Chennai Corporation has stated that the work is in progress and more than 75% (90.25%) of first instalment amount has been utilized. The details of expenditure made is as follows:

- 5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner, Greater Chennai Corporation hereby accord sanction and release an amount of Rs.14.09 crore (Rupees fourteen crore and nine lakh only) (for the second instalment of 33% of the project cost) for the construction of High level bridges across Cooum river connecting Ponnamallee High Road and Union Road at Chinna Nolambur under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund.
- 6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"2217 - Urban Development - 05 - Other Urban Development Schemes - 800 - Other Expenditure - State's Expenditure - KA Schemes implemented in Urban Local Bodies under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund - 309 - Grants-in-Aid - 02 -Grants for creation of Capital Assets. (IFHRMS DPC: 2217-05-800-KA-30902)".

The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be met from the State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund by adjusting under the following head of account:-

"2217 - Urban Development - 05 - Other Urban Development Schemes - 902 - Deduct - Amount met from Reserve Fund -State's Expenditure - JC - Amount met from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund - 330 - Inter Account Transfers - 01 - Inter Account Transfers. (IFHRMS DPC: 2217-05-9020-JC-33001)".
