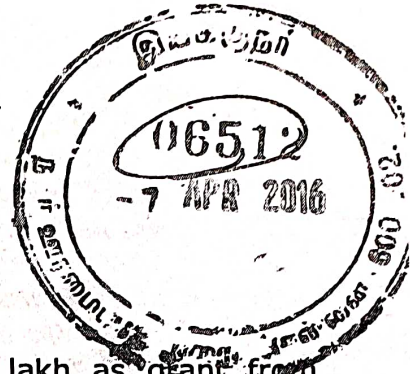




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ABSTRACT

Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board - Release of Rs.826.40 lakh as grant from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund towards Additional State share for tenements construction projects at Ammankulam under the Basic Services for the Urban Poor component of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission- Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

The Government vide order first read above has accorded Administrative Sanction for revised project cost of Rs.5825.26 lakh for construction of 1608 tenements at four alternate locations namely, Ammankulam, Malumichampatti Phase I, Ukkadam Phase II and Vellalore Phase II in lieu of Ammankulam in Coimbatore District with the following funding pattern and to bear the additional cost of Rs.826.40 lakh as State share:-

2. The Managing Director, vide the reference second read above, has stated that out of 1608 tenements, 792 tenements have been completed in Ammankulam and allotted to the beneficiaries. Balance 816 tenements are structurally completed

and the infrastructure works are under progress in the remaining three locations namely, Malumichampatti Phase-I, Ukkadam Phase- II and Vellalore Phase -II in Coimbatore and the said projects are slated for completion by 31.3.2016.

3. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has also stated the works on the construction of tenements in the above locations are in advanced stage and the infrastructure works such as Water Supply, Sanitation arrangements, Storm Water Drain, Sewage Treatment plant, Roads, Pavements, Culverts, Street lights, Parks, and Community facilities are programmed for completion by March, 2016 and has requested to release the Additional State share of Rs.826.40 lakh for construction of 1608 tenements and to complete the infrastructure works as per schedule.

4. The Director of Town and Country Planning vide the reference third read above, has informed that the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee through Circulation Note has sanctioned Rs.826.40 lakh as grant from the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund towards additional State share for construction of 1608 tenements at Ammankulam and has requested the approval of the Government for the above sanction accorded by the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee.

5. Further, the Director of Municipal Administration vide the reference fourth read above, has requested the Government to release the Additional State Share of Rs.826.40 lakh for the said works under the Basic Services for the Urban Poor component of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission.

6. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Director of Town and Country Planning / the Director of Municipal Administration and accord approval for the sanction of Rs.8,26,40,000 (Rupees Eight crore twenty six lakh forty thousand only) as grant from the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund made by the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee towards additional State share for the tenements construction projects as detailed at para 1 above under the Basic Services for the Urban Poor component of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission.

7. The amount sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following heads of account:-

General Component (74%) – Rs.611.54 lakh

9. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 6 above by means of an account payee cheque drawn in favour of "Commissioner of Municipal Administration's BSUP & IHSDP Savings Account No.50100062940381" maintained in the HDFC Bank, Chennai.

The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is requested to furnish a copy of this Government Order along with the details of expenditure incurred under para 6 above to the Director of Town and Country Planning for making necessary adjustments regarding the contra debit entries mentioned in para 7 through the Accountant General (A&E), Chennai at the close of Financial Year 2015-2016.


