ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, in-principle approval was accorded for the work of forming link road and construction of bridge across Buckingham canal connecting Rajiv Gandhi Salai and East Coast Road at Neelankarai at an estimated cost of Rs.204.20 crore.

2. In the letter second read above, the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning (i/c.) has stated that the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion committee held on 04-03-2014 has resolved the proposal of the Highways Department and recommended to the Government, to sanction a sum of Rs.4.20 crore for 2013-2014, Rs.100.00 crore for 2014-2015, and Rs.100.00 crore for 2015-2016 totally Rs.204.20 crore for forming link road and construction of bridge across Buckingham canal connecting Rajiv Gandhi Salai and East Coast road at Neelankarai."

3. The Government, after careful consideration has decided to accept the recommendation of the state Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee and accord administrative sanction for Rs.4.20 crore for 2013-2014, Rs.100.00 crore for 2014-2015, and Rs.100.00 crore for 2015-2016 totally Rs.204.20 crore (Rupees Two hundred and four crore and Twenty lakh only) for forming link road and construction of bridge across Buckingham canal connecting Rajiv Gandhi Salai and East Coast road at Neelankarai."

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para - 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

5054-Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges-80-General-800-Other expenditure-Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II - State Plan-KJ-Works executed by Chief Engineer (Metro), Highways from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund - 16-Major works. (DPC 5054 -80-800- KJ-1603).

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5. The expenditure sanctioned in para - 3 above shall be adjusted by deducting under following head of account:-

5054 - Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges - 80 - General - 902 - Deduct - Amount met from Infrastructure and Amenities Development Fund - Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan - II - State Plan - JB - Deduct - Amount met from Infrastructure Amenities Funds - 30 - Inter Account Transfers. (DPC 5054 -80-902- JB-3004).

By Contra debiting the head of account:-

J - Reserve Funds - (b) Reserve Funds not bearing Interest - 8229-00-Development and Welfare Funds - 200 - Other Development and Welfare Fund - AZ - State Infrastructure and Amenities Funds. (DPC 8229-00-200-AZ-0005) (outgo)

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.104.20 crore will be provided in RE/FMA 2014-15 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para - 3 above. Pending provision of funds in RE/FMA 2014-15, the Chief Engineer (Metro) is authorised to incur the expenditure. This should be brought to the notice of Legislative by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2014-15. The Chief Engineer (Metro) is requested to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the Budget Proposal for RE/FMA 2014-15 and also to send necessary Explanatory Notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2014-15 to Finance (BG-I / PW-I) Department, without fail.


