Municipal Administration – Demolition and Reconstruction of bridge across Virugambakkam in Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) - Development works at Sangalur Pallam in Coimbatore Corporation - Replacement of Causeway with High Level Bridge across vaigai river in Madurai Corporation – Road works, Storm Water Drain, Culverts Street light etc., in 5 Municipalities in Theni District - Administrative sanction at an estimated cost of Rs.131.69 Crore – Financial sanction from Infrastructure and Amenities fund – Accorded – Orders – Issued.

From the Director of Town and Country Planning, Letter No.4442/2019/NPD, dated 12.10.2020 and 21.10.2020.

ORDER:-

In the letter read above, the Director of Town and Country Planning has sent proposal seeking Administrative Sanction and Financial Sanction for the projects in Chennai, Coimbatore, Madurai Corporations and 5 Municipalities in Theni District at an estimated cost of Rs.131.69 Crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund.

2. The Director of Town and Country Planning has furnished the following relevant details in this regard:-

(i) A proposal seeking fund amounting to Rs. 17.81 Crore under Infrastructure and Amenities fund has been received from the Commissioner, Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) for Demolition and Reconstruction of bridge across Virugambakkam-Arumbakkam canal at Kalliamman Koil Street in Greater Chennai Corporation. The Commissioner, Greater Chennai Corporation has stated that the Kalliamman Koil Street is a vital link road connecting Jawaharlal Nehru Salai and N.S.K. Salai which is narrow and a huge volume of traffic and lakhs of people are travelling using this road since it cuts short the travel distance to reach the above two roads. Further, this road serves as main access to the Koyambedu Bus Terminus, Koyambedu wholesale market and Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) Depot and nearby areas such as Valasaravakkam, Virugambakkam, Saligramam, Chinmaya Nagar, Nerkundram and Porur.

(ii) Another proposal seeking fund amounting to Rs.94.353 Crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund has been received from Commissioner of Municipal Administration for development works at Sangapur Pallam from Mettupalayam Road to Sathy Road to be taken in Coimbatore City Corporation.

(iii) The Commissioner of Municipal Administration has stated that the municipal commissioner of Theni-Allinagaram, Chinnamunur, Cumbum, Periyakulam, Gudalur Municipalities in Theni district has informed that works to be taken under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund given below are very essential and important works for the concerned Municipality. In this regard, the Commissioner of Municipal Administration has informed that no adequate funds are available to implement the works given below:-

(iv) Another proposal seeking fund amounting to Rs.24.00 Crore under Infrastructure and Amenities fund has been received from the Commissioner of Municipal Administration for Replacement of Causeway with High Level Bridge across vaigai river behind Rajaji Hospital (Opulpadithurai) with approach road connecting Panagal Road to Munichalai project cost.

3. The above 4 proposals have been circulated to the State Infrastructure Amenities Promotion Committee. The Committee has decided that the estimate may be proportionately reduced to restrict total allocation to Rs.100.00 Crore. The balance can be funded by the organization.

Planning has requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.100 crore as follows:-

6. Accordingly, the Government accord Administrative Sanction at an estimated cost of Rs.131.69 Crore (Rupees one hundred and thirty one Crore and sixty nine lakhs only) and Financial Sanction for Rs.89.35 Crore (Rupees eighty nine crore and thirty five lakhs only) from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for the projects in Greater Chennai Corporation, Coimbatore Corporation, Madurai Corporation and 5 Municipalities in Theni District.

7. The amount sanctioned in Para 6 above shall be debited into the following head of account:-

"2217.Urban Development - 05. Other Urban Development Schemes - 800. Other Expenditure - State's Expenditure - KA. Schemes implemented in Urban Local Bodies under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund - 309. Grants in Aid- 02. Grants for creation of Capital Assets".

The Director of Town and Country Planning is also directed to send necessary draft explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2020-2021 to Government in Finance (BG-I/MAWS) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

9. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration shall furnish a copy of the Government Order along with the details of expenditure incurred out of the above funds sanctioned in Para 6 above to the Director of Town and Country Planning and the Accountant General (A&E), Chennai for making necessary adjustment entries mentioned in Para 7 at the end of Financial Year 2020-21.


