ORDER:

The Commissioner, Tiruppur City Municipal Corporation in his letter first read above has stated that a proposal seeking funds to the tune of Rs.403 Lakhs has been sent to the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning to be obtained from the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund to the Tiruppur City Municipal Corporation for Construction of pedestrian Sky Walk Steel Bridges at six locations in Tiruppur City.

2) The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning in the letter second read above has stated that the subject was placed before the Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee meeting held on 17.05.2013 (Agenda No.7) and the Committee decided as follows:-

"The Committee decided to recommend for sanction of Rs.403 lakhs to Tiruppur City Municipal Corporation for Corporation for Construction of pedestrian sky walk steel Bridges at the following six places, provided the road median is provided in all the roads preventing pedestrians from crossing the road".

3) The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has therefore, sent the above proposal to Government for issue of necessary orders

4) The Government carefully examined the proposal of the The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning for sanction of Rs.403 lakhs (Rupees four crore and three lakhs only) from the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund to Tiruppur City Municipal Corporation for Construction of pedestrian sky walk steel Bridges at six places mentioned in para 2 above in Tiruppur City Municipal Corporation and issue orders accordingly.

5) The amount sanctioned in para-4 above shall be debited into the following new head of account opened under Demand No:34-02.

“2217. Urban Development -05. Other Urban Development Schemes -191 Assistance to Municipal Corporations – Schemes in Twelfth Five Year Plan- II. State Plan- K.B Schemes implemented under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund-09 Grants in aid-02 Grants for creation of Capital assets”.(DPC;2217-05-191-KB-0925)

6) The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 shall be adjusted by deducting under following new head of account opened under Demand No:34-02.

“2217. Urban Development -05. Other Urban Development Schemes -902 Deduct- Amount met from Infrastructure Development Fund JC Amount met from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund -30. Inter Account Transfers (DPC;2217-05-902-JC-3002)

Contra debiting from, “ J. Reserve funds (b) Reserve Funds not bearing Interest 8229-00. Development and Welfare Funds – 200. Other Development and Welfare Funds – AZ State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund. (DP-8229-00-200-AZ-0005) (out go)

7) The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling authority of the New Heads of Account above mentioned in para 5 and 6 above.

8) The concerned Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer's are requested to open to make necessary adjustments at the end of the financial year 2013-14.

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9) This expenditure shall constitute an item of "New Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund orders regarding which will be issued by the Government in Finance (BBG-1) Department, separately. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is directed to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BBG-1) Department, in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of advance from Contingency Fund acquired immediately for the correct financial year.

10) The Accountant General, Chennai-18 is requested to make necessary adjustments at the end of the financial year 2013-2014.

11) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No. 48577/Finance (MAWS)/ 13, Dated 05.12.2013 and with ASL No.1996 (one thousand nine hundred and ninety six).


