Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation – Improvement works for approach roads to the proposed High level bridge at Sundakamuthur road across Noyyal River and the improvements to the Ring Road at Kovaipudur – Sanctioning of Rs.15.00 crores from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

Based on the proposal received from the Commissioner, Coimbatore Corporation, the Director of Town and Country Planning in his letter first read above has stated as follows:-

- I. Coimbatore Corporation has proposed to construct a high level bridge at Sundakamuthur road across the Noyyal River, for which Technical sanction has already been obtained from the Commissioner of Municipal Administration and tenders have been floated.
- II. The existing approach roads to the proposed bridge are Perur Bye-pass road and Kovaipudur road. These approach roads are now connecting Perur Selvapuram Bye-pass road, Pallakad main road and Kovaipudur roads. If the above roads are improved with required widening it will greatly reduce the traffic congestion along the Pallakkad Main National Highways road and benefit more than one lakh people of Coimbatore City.
- III. The above works will be taken up with the following estimate of cost:-

<i>For the proposed high level bridge</i>	Rs.02.25 crore
<i>Improvement of 7.9 Kms. roads</i>	Rs.12.75 crore
Total	Rs.15.00 crore

The Commissioner, Coimbatore Corporation has requested the Director of Town and Country Planning, to sanction an amount of Rs.15.00 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund, for implementation of the above projects.

2. The Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has informed that the subject was placed before the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee in its 10th meeting held on 25.10.2012, and the Committee decided as follows:-

"The Committee decided to recommend for sanction of Rs.15.00 crore from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for the proposal of construction of high level bridge and improvement to roads-7.9 Kms at a total cost of Rs.15.00 crore at Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation."

3. Therefore, the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has requested the Government to issue necessary order for the sanction of Rs.15.00 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for construction of high level bridge and improvement of 7.9 Kms roads, at a total cost of Rs.15.00 crore at Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation.

4. In the letter second read above, the Commissioner of Municipal Administration has stated that based on his recommendation the above proposal of the Commissioner, Coimbatore Corporation has been placed before the Promotion Committee by the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning.

5. The Government after careful examination accepts the proposal of the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning and sanction a sum of Rs.15.00 crore (Rupees fifteen Crores only) to Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation from the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for construction of high level bridge at Sundakamuthur road across Noyyal River and improvement to the ring road at Kovaipudur, as resolved in the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee meeting held on 25.10.2012.

6. The amount sanctioned in para-5 above shall be debited into the following new head of account opened under Demand No.34. HOD. 02

"4217. Capital Outlay on Urban Development - 60. Other Urban Development Schemes - 051. Construction - Schemes in Twelfth Five year plan - II. State Plan - JR. Assistance for the construction works in Municipal Corporations from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund - 16. Major Works". (DPC: 4217-60-051 - JR-1606)

7. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is the Estimating, Reconciling and controlling authority of the New Head of Account mentioned in para 6 above.

8. The Accountant General, Chennai-18 is requested to make necessary adjustments at the end of the financial year 2013-2014 and the concerned PAO / TO's are requested to open the above mentioned new heads in their books.

9. The above expenditure shall be adjusted by deducting under following head of account:-

"2217- Urban Development – 05- Other Urban Development Schemes – 902- Deduct- Amount met from Infrastructure Development Fund- JB. Amount met from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund – 30. Inter Account. Transfers (DPC: 2217-05-902-JB-3004) by contra debiting from, "J. Reserve funds (b) Reserve Funds not bearing Interest – 8229-00. Development and Welfare Fund – 200. Other Development and Welfare Fund – AZ. State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund" (DPC-8229-00-200-AZ-0005) (outgo)

10. The item of expenditure is treated as "**New Service**". The approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which the Government in Finance (BG-I) Department will issue separately. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is directed to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG-I) Department, in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance required for the current year from Contingency Fund, without fail.

11. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.35331/MAWS/13, dated 10.07.2013 and ASL No.667 (Six hundred and sixty seven)
