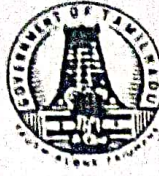
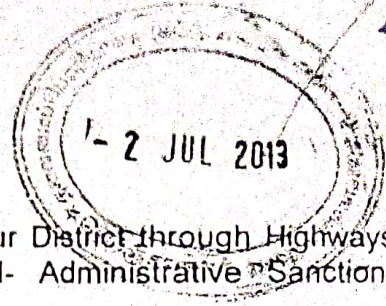

ORDER:

The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance) Highways Department in his letter second read above has stated that, the following works in Perambalur District have been recommended by the District Collector, Perambalur to the Director of Town and Country Planning Chennai as part of the improvements proposed in the Master Plan document and Local Planning area of the Perambalur District.

2. The Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance) Highways Department has also stated that, in the minutes of the meeting of the State Infrastructure and Amenities

Promotion Committee held on 27-08-2012 it was observed that, the committee decided to allocate a sum of Rs.19.95 crores to the Highways Department, under Infrastructure and Amenities fund, the escalation cost of Rs.3.00 crores may be met out from Infrastructure and Amenities fund.

3. The Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance), Highways Department has further stated that, the Commissioner of Town and Country Planning has requested the Government, to sanction necessary funds to the tune of Rs.25.14 crores to complete the project based on the acceptance given by the Promotion Committee during the meeting held on 27-08-2012. Since the above works have already been approved by the Promotion Committee, the above works can be taken up through Highways Department upon sanction of necessary funds.

4. The Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance) Highways Department has, therefore requested the Government to accord administrative sanction at a total cost of Rs.25.14 crores including land acquisition for taking up the above works through Highways Department.

5. The Government after careful examination, accord administrative sanction for taking up the works of widening Inter mediate Lane to Double Lane in Km.0/0-8/0 & 9/5-21/0 and Single Lane to Double Lane Km.8/0-9/5 and improvements to Km.0/0-21/0 of Alathur- Chettikulam- Senjeri road including CD Works, providing link road from Athur- Perambalur road to Perambalur by pass road (via) Elambalur Village Km.0/0-4/7 and widening Single Lane to Double Lane and improvements to Km.0/0-7/2 of Chettikulam- Nakkasalem road in Perambalur District under State Infrastructure Amenities Fund at a total cost of Rs.25.14 crores (Rupees Twenty five crores and fourteen lakhs only) including land acquisition cost through Highways Department.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above, shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"5054- Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges- 04- District and Other Roads- 337- Road Works- Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-II- State Plan-KB- Schemes implemented under State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund- Controlled by Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways-

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above, shall be adjusted by deducting under following head of account:-

"5054- Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges- 04- District and Other Roads- 902- Deduct- Amount met from Infrastructure Development Fund- Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-II- State Plan-JA- Deduct- Amount met from Infrastructure Amenities Fund- 30- Inter Account Transfers."

8. Necessary additional funds will be provided in Revised Estimates/ Final Modified Appropriation 2013-2014 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above. Pending provision of funds in Revised Estimates/ Final Modified Appropriation 2013-2014, the Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance), is authorised to incur the expenditure. This should be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2013-2014. The Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance), is requested to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the Budget Proposal for Revised Estimates/ Final Modified Appropriation 2013-2014 and also to send necessary Explanatory Notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2013-2014 to Finance (BG-I) Department, without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.28403/PW-I/2013, dated 25-06-2013 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.469 (Four hundred and Sixty nine).
