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ORDER:

In the letter 3rd read above, the Director of Town and Country Planning has sent the proposal of the Member Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority seeking funds for a sum of Rs. 33.625 crores for providing Infrastructure and Amenities towards improving the condition of Koyambedu Wholesale Market Complex. An estimate to the tune of Rs. 33.625 crores for the following works has been prepared by the Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority.

2. The Director of Town and Country Planning has stated that the Member Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority, has informed him that the works indicated in para 1 above are essential in view of alienation of land including roads and drains to M/s Chennai Metro Rail for their on going project from Koyambedu Wholesale Market Complex land and

requested to sanction a sum of Rs. 33.625 crores for the above mentioned works from the State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund.

3. The Director of Town and Country Planning has also stated that during the 2nd meeting of the Promotion Committee for State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund held on 31.8.2010, the Committee has recommended this proposal to Government for sanction of Rs. 33.625 crores towards improving the condition of the Koyambedu Wholesale Market Complex

4. In view of the above, the Director of Town Country Planning has forwarded the proposal of Member Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority to Government and has requested to sanction a sum of Rs. 33.625 crores from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund as grant towards carrying out the works like widening and strengthening of roads, providing Storm Water Drains and laying of CC Road at Koyambedu Wholesale Market Complex, Chennai as indicated in para 1 above.

5. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Member Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority/Director Town and Country Planning in para 4 above. The Government accordingly sanction a sum of Rs. 33,62,50,000 (Rupees Thirty Three crores sixty two lakhs and fifty thousands only) from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund as grant towards carrying out the works of widening and strengthening of roads, providing Storm Water Drains and laying of CC Road at Koyambedu Wholesale Market Complex, Chennai, as indicated in para 1 above.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following new head of account opened under Demand No.26-02 for which the Director of Town and Country Planning will be the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling Authority.

"2217 Urban Development - 05 Other Urban Development Schemes - 800 Other Expenditure - "JS" Assistance from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for the Schemes implemented through Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority - 09 Grants-in-Aid- 02 Grants for Capital Expenditure. (DPC 2217-05-800-JS-0929)

7. The expenditure so far incurred shall be adjusted by deducting under following head of account.

"2217 Under Development - 05 Other Urban Development Schemes -902- Deduct - amount met from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund. JB Amount met from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund 30- Inter account transfers (DPC 2217-05-902-JB-3004) by contra debiting from, "J. Reserve Funds (b) Reserve Funds not bearing interest - 8229-00 Development and Welfare Fund - 200 - Other Development and Welfare Fund AZ - State Infrastructure and Amenities Funds (DPC 8229-00-200 AZ-0005) (out go).

8. The Director of Town and Country Planning is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling Authority for the New Head of Account opened at para 6 above.

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of 'New Service' for which approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending

approval, the expenditure will initially be met by drawal of advance from Contingency Fund, orders for which will be issued from Finance (BG.I) Department. The Director of Town and Country Planning, Chennai-2 is authorized to apply for Contingency Fund in Finance (BG.I) Department in the prescribed format along with the copy of this order and requested to send a draft explanatory note to Finance Department for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2010-2011.

10. The Director of Town and Country Planning is requested to draw the amount sanctioned in para 5 above by means of A/c payee cheque in favour of the Member Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority so as to deposit the amount in Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority's PD A/c No.6184513231.

11. The Accountant - General is requested to make necessary adjustments at the end of the financial year 2010-2011.

12. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.64456/Hg/10, dated 22.11.2010 with ASL No. 1387(One Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty Seven)


