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### **ORDER:**

Consequent on the approval of funds for certain projects under Infrastructure & Amenities Fund as grant by the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee in its 19<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13.06.2022 and vide Circulation Note dated 06.02.2023, the Director of Municipal Administration (DMA) in the letter third read above, has sent the following four proposals to the Government for according administrative sanction as follows:-

#### **I. Construction of Onion Market at Mattuthavani Vegetable Market, Madurai Corporation – Ward No.33 at an estimated cost of Rs.10.30 crore.**

The existing onion market is situated in the East Mada Street located very close to Arulmigu Meenakshi Amman Temple, which creates traffic congestion in Madurai City. Therefore, in order to ease traffic congestion in the city, it has been proposed to relocate the onion market to Mattuthavani area.

The Infrastructure and Amenities promotion Committee has allotted Rs.5 crore for this project. The ULB share is Rs.2 crore and the remaining Rs.3.30 crore to be met from Capital Grant Fund for the year 2023-24.

## **II. (A) Eco-Restoration / Rejuvenation & beautification of Vandiyur Tank and Sellur Tank in Madurai Corporation.**

Eco-restoration and beautification of these tanks will help in improving the water quality and protect the tanks from disuse. After rejuvenation and beautification, these tanks will become vibrant urban spaces and recreation centres for the citizens.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister during his visit to Madurai District on 21.01.2022 has announced that

The Director of Municipal Administration has submitted a proposal to the Infrastructure and Amenities promotion committee and the committee has allocated Rs.55.60 crore for the rejuvenation and beautification of these two tanks (Rs.50.00 crore for Vandiyur lake and Rs.5.60 crore for Sellur tank).

In the meantime, the Water Resources Department vide G.O (2D) No.82, Dated 30.11.2022 have accorded administrative sanction for rejuvenation of Sellur tank. The Director of Municipal Administration has stated that the scope of the work proposed for Sellur tank by Madurai Corporation and Water Resources Department is same. The Director of Municipal Administration has further informed that with regard to Eco-restoration of Vandiyur Tank, Commissioner, Madurai Corporation informed that the scope of the work approved by Water Resource Department is entirely different from the works proposed by Madurai Corporation. Therefore, the Director of Municipal Administration has submitted a revised proposal wherein the Rejuvenation and beautification of Vandiyur tank alone has been proposed at an estimated cost of Rs.50.00 crore.

## **(B) Rejuvenation & Beautification of Mokkaneri, Bodinayakkanpatti and Allikuttai Lakes in Salem Corporation.**

Mokkaneri lake is the largest lake in the Salem city, naturally formed under the foothills of Yercaud and it is one of the very old systems of tank in Thirumani Mutharu River. Bodinayakkanpatti lake is located adjacent to the Salem Railway Station with thick natural vegetation with lot of eco system which needs to be protected. The adjacent areas around Allikuttai Lake gets frequently flooded / inundated during the monsoon periods. Therefore, the Allikuttai lake needs to be rejuvenated and strengthened. Rejuvenation and beautification of these lakes will improve the water storage capacity, will protect these lakes from disuse and will also create vibrant urban recreation spaces in the city. Hence, it has been proposed to rejuvenate these three lakes in Salem City.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister during his visit to Salem District on 11.12.2021 has announced that

The Director of Municipal Administration has submitted a proposal for rejuvenation and beautification of these 3 lakes at an estimated cost of Rs.52.00 crore (Mokkeaneri lake : Rs.23 crore + Bodinayakkanpatti lake : Rs.19 crore + Allikuttai lake : Rs.10 crore) and the proposal has been approved by the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee.

The proposals have been appraised by the Joint Technical Committee comprising of TNUIFSL / TUFIDCO and technical officials from the Directorate of Municipal Administration as follows:

**III. Construction of new access-cum-diversion road with retaining wall from Agnitheertham to BSNL Office in Rameshwaram Municipality at an estimated cost of Rs.24.80 crore.**

Rameshwaram is a renowned pilgrimage centre which is visited by a large number of people from all over the country throughout the year. Hundreds of vehicle cross the Thittakudi junction daily to reach Rameshwaram Temple. Hence, the construction of above road, will reduce the traffic congestion considerably.

The Joint Technical Committee comprising the officials of Tamil Nadu Urban Infrastructure Financial Services Limited and technical officials from Directorate of Municipal Administration (DMA) have appraised the proposal for construction of new access-cum-diversion road with retaining wall from Agnitheertham to BSNL office road and arrived the appraised cost at Rs.24.80 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund 2022-23.

**IV. Storm water drain with cover slab in Manjaleneer Kalvai in Kancheepuram Corporation at an estimated cost of Rs.40 crore.**

The State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee has approved Rs.40.00 crore for construction of storm water drain with cover

slab in Manjaleneer kalvai in Kancheepuram Corporation. It will facilitate proper disposal of the storm water. It will also help in decongesting the city, as the top of the drain will be used as a road.

Based on the approval of the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee, the Kancheepuram Corporation Commissioner has submitted Detailed Project Report for the above work at an estimated cost of Rs.40.00 crore.

The proposal has been appraised by the Joint Technical Committee comprising the officials of Tamil Nadu Urban Infrastructure Financial Services Limited (TNUIFSL) and technical officials from the of Directorate of Municipal Administration (DMA) for the above project.

2. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Municipal Administration and hereby accord administrative sanction for implementation of following works at an estimated cost of Rs.177.10 crore (Rupees one hundred seventy seven crore and ten lakh only) [viz.Rs.171.80 crore from Infrastructure & Amenities fund for the year 2022-2023; Rs.2 crore ULB share; and Rs.3.30 crore from Capital Grant Fund (2023-24).
