**ABSTRACT**

Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board - Formation of approach road and construction of one RCC bridge with retaining wall from Palakkad main road to Kulathupalayam for Nethajipuram scheme at Kulathupalayam, Coimbatore District at cost of Rs.14,48,27,810 - Sanction of under Infrastructure and Amenities fund - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the letter second read above, the Director of Town and Country Planning has stated that a proposal seeking fund amounting to Rs.1511.80 lakhs under Infrastructure and Amenities fund has been received from the Managing Director Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board for formation of approach road, construction of one RCC bridge with retaining wall from Palakkad main road to Kulathupalayam via Sengulam tank bund and providing street lights. Further, it has been stated that Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is constructing 720 tenements at Nethajipuram (Kulathupalayam) in Coimbatore under Affordable Housing Programme of PMAY - Housing for All at a project cost of Rs.6253.00 lakh and the work is under progress now. This scheme is located at a distance of 4 Km from Coimbatore - Palakkad Road in an extent of 2.47 hectares of land. The slum families residing in objectionable locations in the surroundings of Kulathupalayam are proposed to be resettled in the tenements. The existing approach road to the scheme is narrow with many curves and houses are existing. After the resettlement of families in the scheme, the existing road cannot accommodate vehicle movements and may cause road accidents.

2. The Director of Town and Country Planning has further stated that during the inspection by the Hon'ble Minister for Municipal Administration, Rural Development and Implementation of Special Programme, the local residents represented the Hon'ble Minister for formation of separate scheme approach road along Sengulam tank bund. Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board approached the Coimbatore

Corporation and requested to form a separate scheme approach road for Nethajipuram scheme along Sengulam tank bund. The Commissioner, Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation has sent a detailed project report for the formation of scheme approach road from Palakkad main road to Kulathupalayam via Sengulam tank bund. The Commissioner has informed that due to present financial crunch in Coimbatore Corporation, financial assistance has to be arranged by Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board. The total cost for the formation of approach road and construction of one RCC bridge with retaining wall from Palakkad main road to Kulathupalayam via Sengulam tank bund, and providing street lights works out to Rs.1511.80 lakh. The financial statement for the work is also furnished. There is no provision in the approved financial statement of the scheme to meet this expenditure. It is therefore, proposed to seek funding assistance of Rs.1511.80 lakh under Infrastructure & Amenities funds for the formation of scheme approach road for Nethajipuram scheme at Kulathupalayam, Coimbatore District.

3. The Director of Town and Country Planning has further stated that the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee has approved the proposal of sanction of a sum of Rs.1511.80 lakh as grant under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for above purpose.

4. The Director of Town and Country Planning has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary order to sanction a sum Rs.1511.80 lakh to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board from the State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for the formation of approach road, construction of one RCC bridge with retaining wall from Palakkad main road to Kulathupalayam via Sengulam tank bund and providing street lights.

5. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Director of Town and Country Planning to accord sanction for a sum Rs.14,48,27,810 (Rupees Fourteen crore Forty eight lakh Twenty Seven thousand Eight hundred and Ten only) to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board from the State Infrastructure and Amenities fund for the formation of scheme approach road for Nethajipuram scheme at Kulathupalayam, Coimbatore District, construction of one RCC bridge with retaining wall from Palakkad main road to Kulathupalayam via Sengulam tank bund and providing street lights and also for providing greening along the stretch and its maintenance within the sanctioned amount.

6. The amount sanctioned in the paragraph 5 above, shall be debited under the following heads of account:-

"2217 Urban Development – 05 Other Urban Development Schemes – 800 Other Expenditure – State's Expenditure – JW Assistance from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for Schemes implemented through TNSCB – 309 Grants-in-Aid – 02 Grants for Creation of Capital Assets".

The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be met from the State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund by adjusting under the following Head of Account:

The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is requested to furnish a copy of this Government Order along with the details of expenditure incurred under para 5 above to the Director of Town and Country Planning for making necessary adjustments regarding the contra debit entries mentioned in para 6 through the Accountant General (A&E), Chennai at the close of Financial Year 2020-2021.
