Infrastructure and Amenities Fund – Administrative Sanction accorded – Release of 33% of project cost of Rs.57.34 crore of Infrastructure and Amenities Fund as first installment for implementation of various works in Urban Local Bodies – sanctioned - Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued to accord administrative sanction at an estimated cost of Rs.162.90 crore [viz. Rs.159.90 crore from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund and Rs.3 crore from Urban Local Body share] for implementing various works in Urban Local Bodies.

2. Consequent to the above, in the letter second read above, the Director of Municipal Administration has stated that, in G.O.(Ms) No.281, Housing and Urban Development [UD4(3)] Department, dated 14.11.2013 orders were issued that, funds for the projects costing more than Rs.5 crore which are funded by Infrastructure and Amenities Charges fund, shall be released in 3 installments i.e. 33% of the project cost as first installment and the second installment of 33% after utilisation of 75% of the first installment and the third installment after utilisation of 75% of the first and second installments by the implementing agency. Hence, the Director of Municipal Administration has requested the Government to release 33% of funds for the works with estimate cost more than Rs.5 crore and the total estimated cost for the works less

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than Rs.5 crore, to a total amount of Rs.57.34 crore under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund, as detailed below:-

3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Municipal Administration, hereby accord financial sanction to release Rs.57.34 crore (Rupees fifty seven crore and thirty four lakh only) being 33% of the project cost as 1st installment under the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for the implementation of various works in Urban Local Bodies as explained at para 2 above.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2217-Urban Development-05-Other Urban Development Schemes - 800-Other Expenditure - State's Expenditure - KA-Schemes implemented in Urban Local Bodies under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund-309-Grants in Aid-02-Grants for creation of Capital Assets".

The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be met from the State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund by adjusting under the following head of account:-

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5. Necessary funds of Rs. 57,34,00,000/- has been provided in the Budget Estimate 2023-2024. The Director of Municipal Administration is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above.

6. The Director of Municipal Administration shall furnish a copy of this Government Order along with the details of expenditure incurred out of the funds sanctioned in para 3 above to the Director of Town and Country Planning and the Accountant General (A&E), Chennai for making necessary adjustment entries mentioned in para 4 above at the close of Financial Year 2023-2024.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance (MA&WS) Department vide its U.O.No.12118/2023, dated 17.04.2023.
