Abstract: Local Planning Area - Madurantakam - Declaration Notification under section 10(4) of the Tamilnadu Town and Country Planning Act 1971- issued.

ORDER:

A proposal notifying the intention of the Government to declare certain local areas forming a local planning area and to constitute for such local planning area, a local planning authority, was published at page 29 of Part II Section 2 of the Tamilnadu Government Gazette dated 8-1-75 for general information as required under sub-section (3) of section 10 of the Tamilnadu Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 (Tamilnadu Act 35 of 1972). No objection or suggestion having been received, the Government declare the local areas specified in column (3) of the table in the Notification appended to this order to be a local planning area by the name specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof.

2. The appended notification will be published in the Tamilnadu Govt. Gazette.

Extension of period of declaration of Manufacture, Marketing and Distribution of Petroleum Products Industry as public utility service for purposes of Industrial Disputes Act.

(G.O. R. No. 2449, Labour and Employment, 20th December 1974.)

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (Central Act XIV of 1947), for a period of six months up to and inclusive of the 31st December 1974 in the Industries, Labour and Co-operation Department Notification No. 2564, dated the 31st May 1967 published at page 1042 of Part I of the Fort St George Gazette, dated the 31st May 1967, read with the Labour and Employment Department Notification No. 11 (2)/LE/3950/74, dated the 25th June 1974 published at page 201 of Part II - Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 3rd July 1974;

And whereas, the Governor of Tamil Nadu is of opinion that public interest requires the extension of the said period for a further period of six months;
