**ORDER:**

In the letter second read above, the Directorate of Town and Country Planning has stated that a proposal seeking fund amounting to Rs.1.6904 crore under Infrastructure & Amenities Fund has been received from the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board for providing Infrastructure in 12 urban slums of Coimbatore District.

2. The Directorate of Town and Country Planning has further stated that the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board has stated as follows:

Tamil Nadu is one of the most urbanized states in the country with 53% of urban population. The primary role of Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board is to improve the slum areas and to make them into a decent habitation. The improvement works like roads, street lights, cement concrete pavement, water supply and storm water drain are taken up in urban poor habitats to upgrade the areas and to make it habitable.

3. The Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board has been executing the development works in urban slums under Environment Improvement of Urban Slums Programme since 2005-06 onwards. The development works have been executed based on the request of local bodies concerned. After execution, the assets created in the urban slums are handed over to the local bodies for further maintenance by themselves.

4. The Urban Local Bodies of Coimbatore District have now requested Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board to provide required infrastructure in 12 urban slums of 8 Town Panchayats. The details on the scheme where infrastructure are required is tabled below:

The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board has requested to sanction Rs.1.6904 crore under Infrastructure & Amenities fund for providing Infrastructure in 12 urban slums of Coimbatore District.

5. The Directorate of Town and Country Planning has also stated that the amount of Rs.1.6904 crore sought by the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board has been approved by the State Infrastructure and Promotion Committee.

6. The Directorate of Town and Country Planning has therefore, requested the Government to issue the necessary orders for sanction a sum of Rs.1.6904 crore to Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board to enable it to make payment to providing Infrastructure in 12 urban slums of Coimbatore District.

7. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Directorate of Town and Country Planning and to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.1,69,04,000/- (Rupees one crore sixty nine lakh and four thousand only) to Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board from the State Infrastructure & Amenities fund to

enable it to make payment to providing Infrastructure in 12 urban slums of Coimbatore District.

8. The amount sanctioned in the para 7 above, shall be debited under the following heads of accounts:-

"2217 Urban Development – 05 Other Urban Development Schemes – 800 Other Expenditure – State's Expenditure – JW Assistance from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund for Schemes implemented through TNUHDB – 309 Grants-in-Aid – 02 Grants for Creation of Capital Assets".

The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be met from the State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund by adjusting under the Head of Account:

"2217 Urban Development – 05 Other Urban Development Schemes – 902 Deduct – Amount met from Reserve Fund – State's Expenditure JB Amount met from State Infrastructure and Amenities Fund – 330 Inter Account Transfers". 01-Inter Account Transfers.

9. The amount sanctioned in para 7 above, shall be drawn by the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board on the basis of progress of work and utilization certificate submitted by Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board and should be contra credited into public Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board under the following head of account:

10. Necessary additional funds of Rs.1,69,04,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2022-2023. Pending Provision of such funds, the Directorate of Town and Country Planning is authorized to draw and transfer the amount sanctioned in para 7 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2022-2023. The Directorate of Town and Country Planning is also directed to include the above expenditure while sending the Budget proposal for RE/FMA 2022-2023 and also send necessary draft explanatory notes for Specific Inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-I/Hg&MAWS) Department at an appropriate time, without fail.

11. The Directorate of Town and Country Planning is authorized to prepare and submit an adjustment entry in the IFHRMS for effecting the above said transfer.

12. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board is requested to furnish a copy of this Government Order along with the details of expenditure incurred under para 7 above to the Director of Town and Country Planning for making necessary adjustments regarding the contra debit entries mentioned in para 9 through the Accountant General (A&E), Chennai in RE/FMA 2022-2023.

13. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board to send separate proposals to Directorate of Town and Country Planning seeking release of funds towards urban slum projects whenever necessary adjust the above fund sanctioned from Infrastructure & Amenities Fund.
