**ORDER:-**

The Director of Municipal Administration in his letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above has stated that the Hon'ble Minister for Municipal Administration during the budget session 2022-2023 has announced on the floor of the Legislative Assembly among others, that new bus stands will be constructed in certain Corporations and Municipalities. The 19<sup>th</sup> State Infrastructure Amenities Promotion Committee vide letter first read above, has approved to provide 50% of the estimated cost for the construction of new bus stands from Infrastructure and Amenities fund, as grant.

2. In the Government Order 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, administrative sanction was accorded initially for the construction of new bus stands at Tiruppur and Hosur Corporations and Guddalur (T), Ariyalur, Vadalur, Vedaranyam, Melur, Pattukottai, Colachal and Pollachi Municipalities.

3. The Director of Municipal Administration in his letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, has now informed that the detailed project reports on construction of new bus stands as per the announcement in

respect of the municipalities viz., Arcot, Idappadi, Ramanathapuram, Tiruvallur, Mettur, Chidambaram and Usilampatti have been Scrutinized. The concept plan and basic provisions have been verified by the committee headed by the Director of Municipal Administration and technical appraisal has been done by the committee headed by Superintending Engineer, Office of the Directorate of Municipal Administration. During appraisal of detailed project reports the estimate cost has been revised, based on the field conditions and current schedule of rates.

4. The Director of Municipal Administration has stated that the balance amount of 50% of estimated cost required for construction of bus stands will be met by dovetailing funds from various other schemes. Since bus stands are mostly located in the high footfall areas, it has been decided to fund the public toilet component by utilising funds under Swachh Bharat Mission 2.0. Likewise, the commensurate cost towards components like compound wall will be met from the 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission Grant untied component. The cost for construction of shops will be met out of the amount to be collected by pre-auction mode of the shops and the works like two wheeler parking shed will be met out by the respective Urban Local Bodies from their own revenue.

5. The Director of Municipal Administration has also stated that the estimate cost, concept plan, financial plan has been prepared for the following 7 Municipalities. The details of funds tie up are as furnished in the table below:-

The Director of Municipal Administration has also stated that the proposed cost of bus stand at Thiruvallur and Mettur has been reduced and hence the amount sanctioned under Infrastructure and amenities Fund is proposed to be re-distributed for Arcot and Usilampatti.

6. The Director of Municipal Administration has requested the Government to accord administrative sanction for the construction of new bus stands at above mentioned 7 municipalities with financial assistance from Infrastructure and amenities Fund, Swachh Bharat



Mission 2.0., 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission Grant, Urban Local Bodies contribution, anticipated income from pre-auction of shops and Capital Grant Fund.

7. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Municipal Administration have decided to accord administrative sanction for Rs.93.40 crore (Rupees ninety three crore and forty lakh only) towards the construction of new bus stands at Arcot, Idappadi, Ramanathapuram, Tiruvallur, Mettur, Chidambaram and Usilampatti Municipalities with the funding pattern as given in the table at paragraph 5 above.

8. The Director of Municipal Administration (DMA) is directed to obtain the approval of the respective project sanctioning committees for utilising funds under Swachh Bharat Mission 2.0. and Capital Grant Fund (CGF). The Director of Municipal Administration is also directed to inform the revised allocation from Infrastructure and Amenities Fund to the Infrastructure and Amenities Committee and also to follow the procedure laid in G.O.(Ms) No.281, Housing and Urban Development (UD4(3)) Department, dated 14.11.2013.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.74/DS (LBT)/2023, dated 22.02.2023.
