ORDER:-

The Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Greater Chennai Corporation has placed the proposal regarding construction of storm water drain in various locations in Zone 5, 9, 10 before the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee.

2. The 18th State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee in its meeting held on 12.10.2021 has resolved to sanction an amount of Rs.26.28 crore from the Infrastructure and Amenities Fund to the Greater Chennai Corporation for construction of Storm Water Drains in 6 locations (27 roads).

3. In the letter read above, the Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Greater Chennai Corporation has furnished the following details relating to the above proposal:

- During North East Monsoon 2019, rain water stagnation was observed at many locations due to heavy rainfall of 140.20 mm on 19.09.2019, 132mm on 18.10.2019 and 112mm on 01.12.2019. The flood monitoring IAS officers appointed by Government and Engineers of Zones and Storm Water Drain Department of the Greater Chennai Corporation have identified the locations which were severely affected due to the fact that the old brick and mortar drains constructed decades ago had got damaged beyond repair and need to be rehabilitated.
- Also, there were few locations wherein new drains have to be constructed due to the recent urbanization in these areas. The old drains were damaged due to frequent repair works and improvement

of infrastructure facilities by various utility departments and the development of residential areas which resulted in damage and chocking of the drains in many of the roads.

- Based on the final list, Detail Project Report was prepared by the Greater Chennai Corporation for 17 locations with cost estimates of Rs.26.28 crore were proposed to be taken up under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund.

4. The Director of Town and Country Planning has informed that the State Infrastructure and Amenities Promotion Committee has sanctioned the above said Rs.26.28 crore for the construction of storm water drains in Greater Chennai Corporation.

The estimate cost for the proposed storm water drains are as follows:-

The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Greater Chennai Corporation, accord administrative sanction for construction of SWD in various locations in Zone 5, 9, 10 at an estimated cost of Rs.26.28 crore (Rupees Twenty Six Crore and Twenty Eight Lakh Only) under Infrastructure and Amenities Fund.
