## **Right To Information Act 2005, Sec 4(1) (b)**

### **1. The particulars of the Town and Country Planning functions and duties.**

The existing Town and Country Planning Act, 1920 was repealed by Town & Country Planning Act (T&CP Act), 1971. The Directorate of Town & Country Planning (DTCP) headed by the Director is functioning under the Tamil Nadu T&CP Act, 1971. It functions under the Housing & Urban Development Department (H&UD) of the Secretariat.

#### **Jurisdiction**

The department has its jurisdiction over the entire Tamil Nadu except Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority (CMDA) area.

#### **Aims / goals of the Directorate**

To provide effective development plans with adequate infrastructure facilities for a conducive living environment required for the society. This is achieved by integrating the physical, economic as well as social planning for the diverse condition viz., physiography, pattern or urbanization, traditional practices, socio economic qualities etc., prevalent in different part of towns and villages.

- i. To achieve socio – economic development of the state through systematic development and regulation of growth urban and rural areas of the State through Master Plans / New Town Development Plans and Detailed Development Plans.
- ii. To arrest the rural migration to cities and towns by rural – urban integration through Regional Plans.
- iii. To preserve the historical, heritage and tourism important places in the state.
- iv. To protect environmentally and ecologically sensitive areas of the state.

#### **Mission**

- i. To prepare regional plans for the state for efficient management of land.
- ii. To prepare master plans for urban areas for sustainable growth of urban areas.
- iii. To review existing master plans to cater the present land use requirements of the public.
- iv. To prepare detailed development plans for an oriented urban growth.
- v. To utilise infrastructure and amenities fund to improve and strengthen basic amenities in urban areas.

#### **Functions**

- i. To notify regional planning area, local planning area, new town development area and detailed development plan area.
- ii. To constitute regional planning authorities, local planning authorities, new town development authorities and urban development authorities.
- iii. To prepare regional plan, master plan, new town development plan and detailed development plan.

- iv. To approve layouts and plans for buildings.
- v. To enforce statutory obligations as set out in the act.
- vi. To assist the local bodies on planning permission.

## **Preparation of Plans**

This department prepares and implements the statutory plans viz., Master Plan, New Town Development Plan and Detailed Development Plan for the planning areas under Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

### **(a) Regional Plan**

The objectives of balanced regional development was sought to be achieved through industrial location policy as through balanced and coordinated development of industrial and agricultural economy in each region, the entire country can attain higher standard of living. In Tamil Nadu the state has been demarcated into 12 regions taking into factors like geographical boundary, resource base, market potential and facilities, population threshold ect. Identification of growth poles, growth centers, service centers and proposal for development of transportation and communication network.

### **(b) Master Plan / New Town Development Plan**

Master Plan / New Town Development Plan is a macro level land use plan prepared for towns with regulatory guidelines to ensure orderly development of the planning area. In the broader sense, it aims at land use regulations and provisions of effective road network fixing alignment of bye-pass roads, ring roads etc. The developments regulated according to the Master plan/ New Town Development Plan prepared it paves way for fair sustainable development of the town improving the quality of life of the urban populace.

### **(c) Detailed Development Plan (DD Plan)**

These are the micro level action plans that are in conformity with the master plans prepared for areas vulnerable for rapid development. The plan contains zoning of land in detail for specific land use, infrastructural facilities like park and play fields, small link roads, roads for proper traffic circulation, public purposes, commercial and industrial areas etc., to facilitate a balanced development within the ambit of the Master plan.

## **Planning permissions**

The Town and country Planning Act 1971 under section 2(b) of 49 requires that anyone who wants to develop any land or building should obtain a planning permission before commencement of the development work. Section III provides that when a permission that has to be taken under this Act is not taken then, the development will be unauthorized even if a permission or license is taken under any other law.

## **Technical Clearance:**

Technical clearance for Layouts and building is given under section 47(A) of the Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act, 1971.

## **Layout**

Technical clearance for Layouts is being given by the Directorate of Town and Country Planning.

- i. More than 10 acres in rural areas and more than 5 acres in urban areas - after issue of technical clearance by the Directorate of Town and Country Planning, Planning Permission is issued by LPA in the planning areas and by JD/DD/AD in the non-planning area in the concerned district office. Final approval given by the local body after handing over of open space reservations, roads etc.
- ii. Up to 10 acres in rural areas and less than 5 acres in urban areas - The concerned Member Secretary issues planning permission and the local body issues layout approval. JD/DD/AD issues technical clearance vide DTCP circular Roc.No.4367/2019/TCP2, dated.11.10.2021.
- iii. Power delegated to district offices for issue of Planning permission for non-high rise building up to 40,000 sq.ft FSI area vide circular Roc.No.7963/2022/K1, Dated.11.04.2023.

## **Building**

Local bodies are delegated powers to issue planning permission and license vide G.O.No.154, H&UD dept., dated.13.10.2020 and G.O.No.265, H&UD dept, dated.21.12.2022.

The Government delegated the powers to Local Bodies (except Chennai) for grant of Planning Permission as follows:

### **Residential Buildings**

Building plan for residential use of total FSI area upto 10,000 sq.ft and upto 8 dwelling units not exceeding 14 meters in height upto Stilt + 3 Floors or Ground + 2 floors.

### **Commercial Buildings**

Upto maximum floor area of 2000 sq.ft consisting of Ground + First floor in single block.
